# Jingle Bells

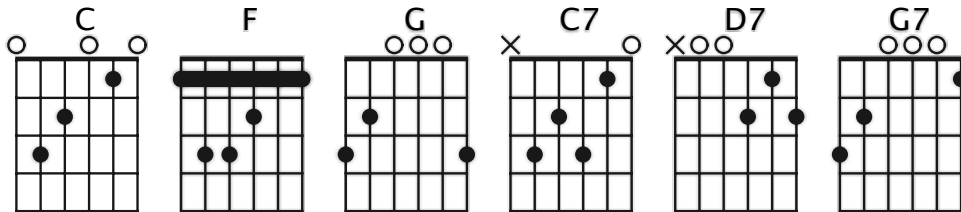
Capo 5th fret

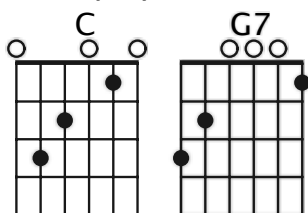

<sup>C</sup> All of the other reindeer

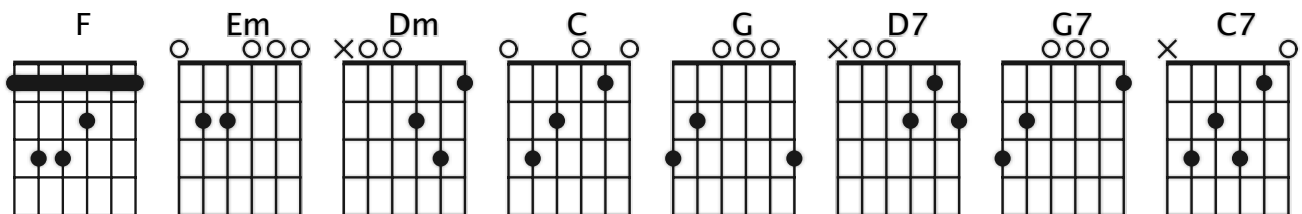
Used to laugh and call him <sup>G7</sup> names

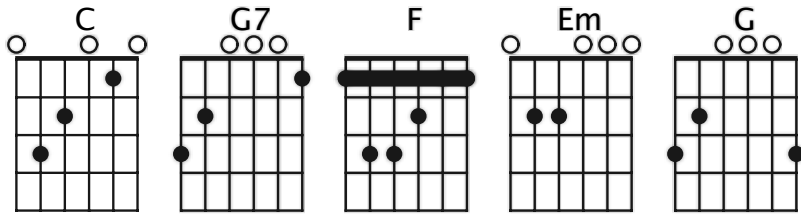


# Here Comes Santa Claus

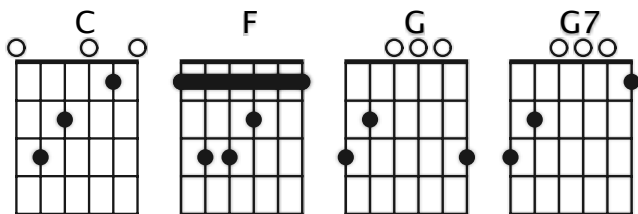

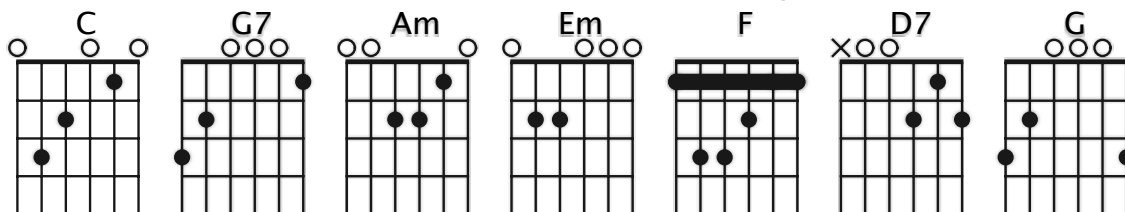
# Jolly Old Saint Nicholas

But we've wandered many a weary foot

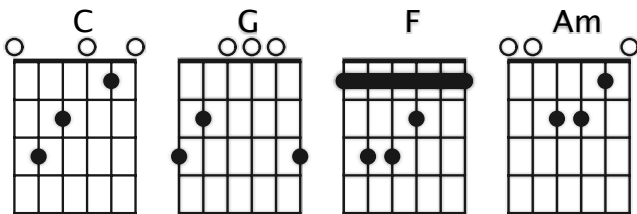
